Cromer Pier Voluntary Code of Conduct ANGLING

Cromer Pier is a popular destination for anglers and other holiday makers. To maximise the enjoyment and safety of all visitors to the pier, we would kindly request that the following guidelines are read and respected.

Bag Limit

2 bass per visit

Rod Limit

2 rods

Hook Limit

2 per rod (i.e. 4 hooks in total)

Please cast responsibly

Keep Cromer Pier clean & tidy

Failure to comply with these rules may lead to exclusion from Cromer Pier

**Legal minimum landing sizes are; 36cm for bass,
27 cm for whiting**

30cm for mackerel, 35 cm for cod

Retaining undersized fish may lead to prosecution
