






***RECREATIONAL BASS MEASURES:**

From 1st January to 29th February 2020 and 1st December to 31st December 2020: catch-and-release only.

From 1st March to 30th November 2020: not more than two bass per person, per day may be retained.

Measurement of a fish

The size of any fish shall be measured, as shown below in Figure 1, from the tip of the snout to the end of the tail fin.

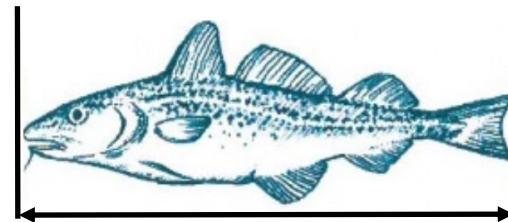

Undersize fish

A marine organism is undersize if its dimensions are smaller than the minimum dimensions specified.

Undersize marine organisms shall not be retained onboard or be transhipped, landed, sold, displayed or offered for sale, but shall be returned immediately to the sea.

Shellfish measures:

Please contact EIFCA for details around minimum legal sizes for shellfish.

Byelaw 14

Prohibition on the removal of Tope or part(s) thereof:

No person shall remove from a fishery any tope of the species (*Galeorhinus galeus*) or part(s) thereof which is detached from the body.

Any tope, if caught, shall be returned immediately to the sea in a position as near to that part of the sea from which it was taken.
