NOTICE TO MARINERS

Shore Leave restrictions for Seafarers due to COVID 19

For the attention of all masters, ship's Agents and Leisure users

All visiting ships are reminded that due to levels of covid 19 infection, the UK remains in national lockdown.

All crew shore leave should be restricted to essential reasons only in line with UK government advice.

In addition, all ship's crew on vessels bound from Portugal should remain onboard until their 10-day quarantine period has passed and may only step ashore to carry out essential operational tasks (such as checking draught marks).
