Dear Owners, Ships Agents, Masters, Pilots and Fishermen,

Re: Galloper Windfarm, RWE - NTM: GWFL-O&M 2021-04 ROV Subsea Inspections

Please be advised that Galloper Windfarm will be carrying out a subsea inspections in the North & South fields for 56 WTG's and the OSP as part of the operation and maintenance programme. The sub-sea inspection work will be carried out using 2 Atlantas Marine ROVs and 2 Offshore Turbine Services (OTS) vessels.

Operations will be during daylight hours with the vessels 'Admiral P' and 'Honor Mhari' sailing to the field from Galloper O&M base in Harwich International Port. Mariners are requested to remain a distance of 50m away from the 2 vessels due to an ROV being launched from the aft starboard side and flown forward by the ROV pilot.
