Approaches to King's Lynn

Amendments to buoyage .

Mariners are advised that due to changes in the profile of the approach channel to King's Lynn, the following amendments to buoyage will take place:

1: on or about 13th April 2021

- a) No. 10 light buoy to be moved approx. 160m x 130°(T) to 52° 52'.590N 00°22'.075E
- b) No. 12 light buoy to be moved approx. 135m x 080°(T) to 52° 52'.315N 00°22'.205E
- c) No. 11 light buoy to be moved approx. 100m x 020°(T) to 52° 52'.475N 00°21'.990E

2: on or about 14th April 2021

- a) No. 8 light buoy to be moved approx. 50m x 085°(T) to 52° 52'.850N 00°21'.765E
- b) No. 17 light buoy to be moved approx. 90m x 280°(T) to 52° 51'.700N 00°21'.195E

All the above works will be carried out by the buoying vessel St Edmund and all mariners are requested to pass at slow speed and give as wide a berth as is possible whilst works are being carried out. Contact the St Edmund on VHF Ch. 14 for further information.
