

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Vessels: CPBS Gundog and CRC Loadstar Site: Vattenfall Norfolk Boreas Site, North of Great Yarmouth

Commencing on or around Tuesday 31st August to Wednesday 8th September 2021 the CPBS “Gundog” multicat and “CRC Loadstar” crew transfer RIB will be carrying out recovery operations of a section of drill casing on the Vattenfall Norfolk Boreas cable route site, 15 nautical miles north of Great Yarmouth. Location reference 52° 49’ 20.78 N 1° 33’ 9.27 E (402468E, 5853500N).

Completion of work is expected to be in 4-5 days however this is extendable by metocean conditions. Diving operations are expected to take place for 1-2 days between 5th and 6th September. Two marked mooring buoys are expected to be on site from 4th September 2021.

CPBS Gundog is a 20m multicat workboat equipped with a 15t crane. It will act as the Dive Support Vessel and will be anchored using a 4-point anchoring system over the work location. Whilst on location, the vessel will support diving operations and lifting operations at the work site.

The Gundog will be supported by CRC Loadstar, conducting crew transfer between Great Yarmouth Harbour and the work site.

The work will take place daytime only however CPBS Gundog will remain onsite for 24hr a day until work is completed.

The Gundog will be stationery at the location for approximately 1-3 days.

Vessels will keep well clear of the work site at all times by a minimum of 100 meters and exercise caution when passing.

Throughout operations the vessels will be displaying the appropriate shapes and lights prescribed in the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) Rule 27, to indicate restricted in ability to manoeuvre.

A listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 16, and the vessels will be actively transmitting an AIS signal.

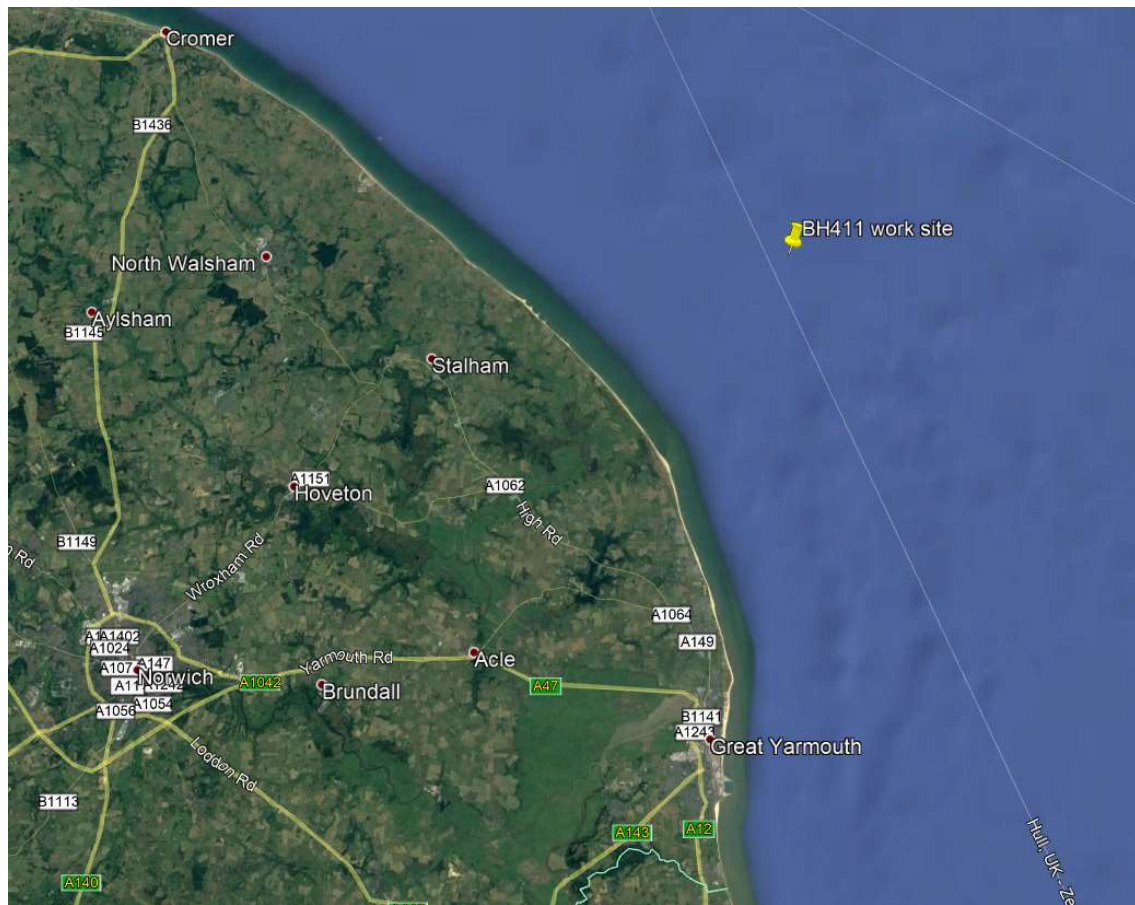


Figure 4: Area of operations

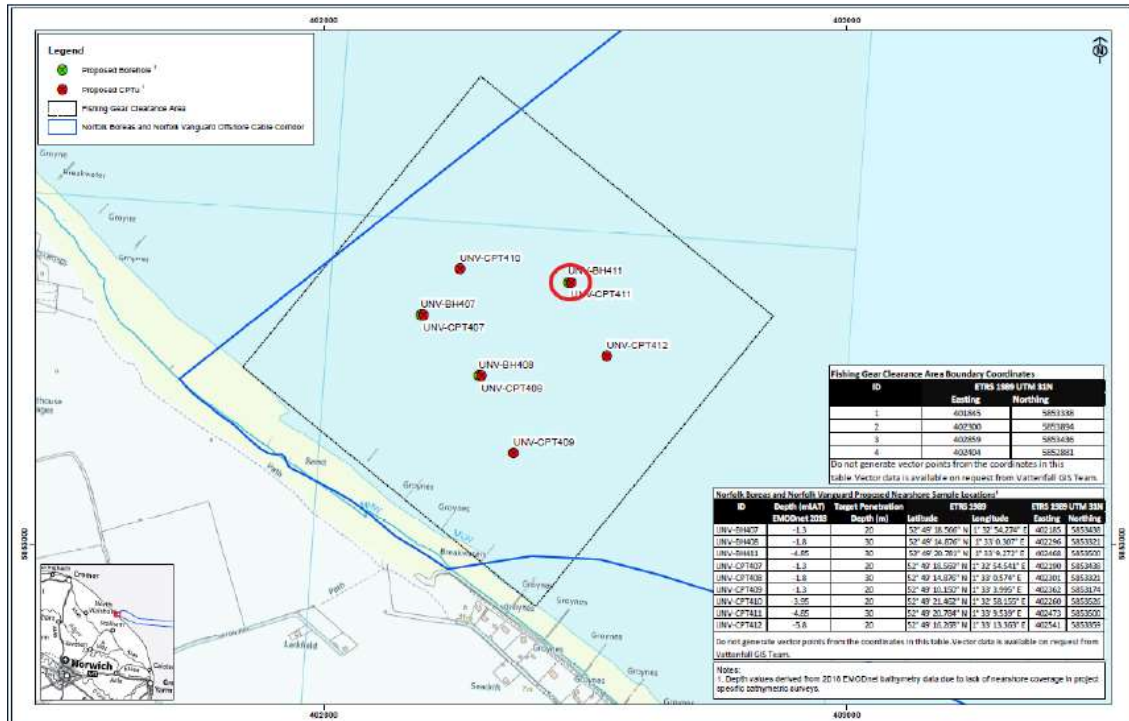


Figure 5: Site Location marked in Red
