Marine Debris Workshop Invitation - North Norfolk - Tue 25th Jan 16:30-19:30

The East of England Plastics Coalition Marine Debris Working Group wants to help tackle the issue of litter in the sea around The Wash and North Norfolk coast.

With the wider aim of **assisting nature recovery**, the proposed project will **support the removal of debris** from marine and coastal environments around The Wash and North Norfolk coast, and **establish sustainable disposal options**, where repair/reuse options are not viable.

Working in partnership with the Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds Marine Conservation Zone (MCZ) Stakeholder Group, a free **online** workshop will be taking place on **Tue 25th Jan**, to share information and discuss ideas about:

- Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds MCZ management: EIFCA Code of Best Practice
- Marine debris in North Norfolk
 - Types and quantities (with a focus on fishing gear)
 - Repair/reuse/recycle options
 - Ways to support the ongoing project
