Dear Owners, Ships Agents, Masters, Pilots and Fishermen,

Re: Galopper Windfarm, RWE - NTM: GWF-O&M 2022-04 v2 ROV inspections - COMPLETE

Please be advised that Galopper Windfarm will be carrying out a subsea inspections in the North & South fields for 56 WTG's and the OSP as well as internal inspections as part of the operation and maintenance programme. The sub-sea inspection work will be carried out by Atlantas Marine in partnership with Offshore Turbine Services (OTS).

The inspection work will be carried out solely using ROV's, operating from vessels 'Admiral P' and 'Captain P'. Both vessels will sail daily to the field from Galopper O&M base in Harwich International Port. Mariners are requested to remain a distance of 50m away from the 2 vessels as the ROV will be launched from the aft starboard side and flown forward by the ROV pilot.
