Local Notice to Mariners EIFCA 05-2022

Issued – 18th August 2022

East Coast of England – North Norfolk Coast

Mariners are advised subject to weather FPV “SEBASTIAN TERELINCK” will be carrying out survey work from Monday 22nd August 2022 until Monday 31st October 2022 between 06:00hrs - 20.00hrs between Weybourne and Mundesley within the boundaries of the Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds Marine Conservation Zone. Surveys will mainly be carried out over Neap tides, however surveys maybe carried out at other times.

Vessels are requested to keep clear and maintain a safe distance as underwater scientific equipment will be deployed during the survey. Whilst equipment is deployed the vessel will have restricted maneuverability. As part of the surveys experimental potting gear will also be deployed on some occasions and marked as below:



Sebastian Terelinck will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16.

This LNTM EIFCA 05-2022 cancels the previous LNTM EIFCA 03-2022 and will be self-cancelling as of midnight on the 31st October 2022.
