

Formal Consultation: Crab & Lobster Byelaw 2023

We have reviewed and are retaining:

- Prohibition on removal 'berried' (eggbearing) or soft shelled Crab or Lobster
- Prohibition on landing parts of shellfish (crabs and lobsters must be landed whole)
 - Prohibition on landing 'white-footed' crab



We have reviewed and are **amending**:

Prohibition on use of edible crab (Cancer pagurus) for bait


It shall be prohibited to use edible crab as bait, with the following exceptions:



Cooked offal as bait in commercial fisheries Use in recreational hook and line fishing (including from a charter vessel), with conditions *
