The 2022 intertidal mussel surveys concluded it would be possible to open a mussel relaying fishery on certain beds in The Wash.




This consultation closes 6th April 2023.

Proposed Total Allowable Catch and Maximum Harvestable Per Open Bed





Once the TAC for a bed is exhausted - Eastern IFCA will give 12 hours' notice of bed closure

Max 8 Tonne per day


Re-laid into Wash and North Norfolk Coast SAC only

- Vessel Hold
- Mussel Dredge



Transshipping is prohibited

To open late April/ early May



Open at all times until TAC exhausted



Maximum:

- 2 dredges
- Inside opening of 1m

Notifications

You must:

- Provide a valid **mobile** phone number
- Notify of intent to fish with 12 hours' notice
- Provide catch return information no later than 2 hours after high water

Notification of transport by road

Notice of intent

- Vessel name & PLN
- Mussel bed to fish
- Method of fishing

Catch return

- Vessel name & PLN
- Bed fished
- Weight of mussel removed
