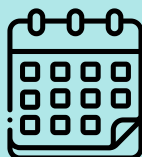


Shrimp Permit Byelaw 2018

Outside the Wash & North Norfolk Coast



To fish for shrimp from August you will need to apply for a permit. If you plan to fish for shrimp, please ensure you have a permit from 1 September 2023



A 'Category 2' Permit will be required to fish for shrimp outside the Wash and North Norfolk Coast SAC

1 Eligibility Requirement



Anyone is eligible for a Category 2 Permit

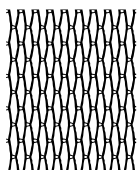


There is no fee for a Category 2 Permit

2 Gear Restrictions



Nets must have a veil net or sorting grid fitted

Shoes must be flat along their entire length



No tickler chains, or any item that penetrates the seabed

3 Catch Returns

- Category 2 permit holders must provide monthly catch returns
- Returns must include location fished using EIFCA Charts

4 Total Allowable Effort

No effort limits will be in place initially
