Project Summary

The Q&E Consortium are installing and operating a new telecommunications cable. The purpose of the cable is to enhance telecommunications services between UK – France.

Global Marine Systems Limited (GMSL) has been contracted to supply and install the subsea system with operations anticipated to commence at the beginning of Q2 2025.

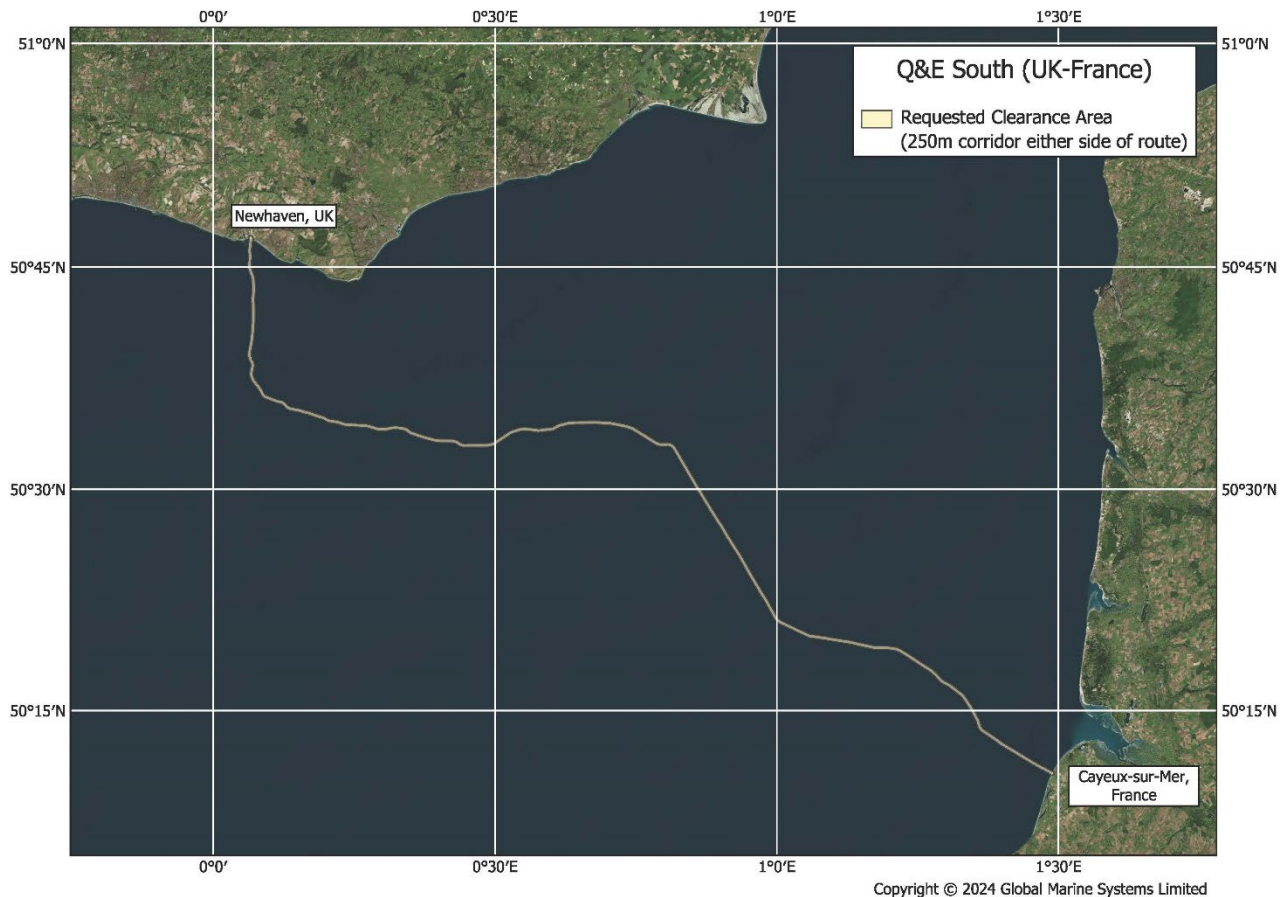


Figure 1 Q&E South Route

An overview chart of the cable route and the landing points is provided in Figure 1 below.

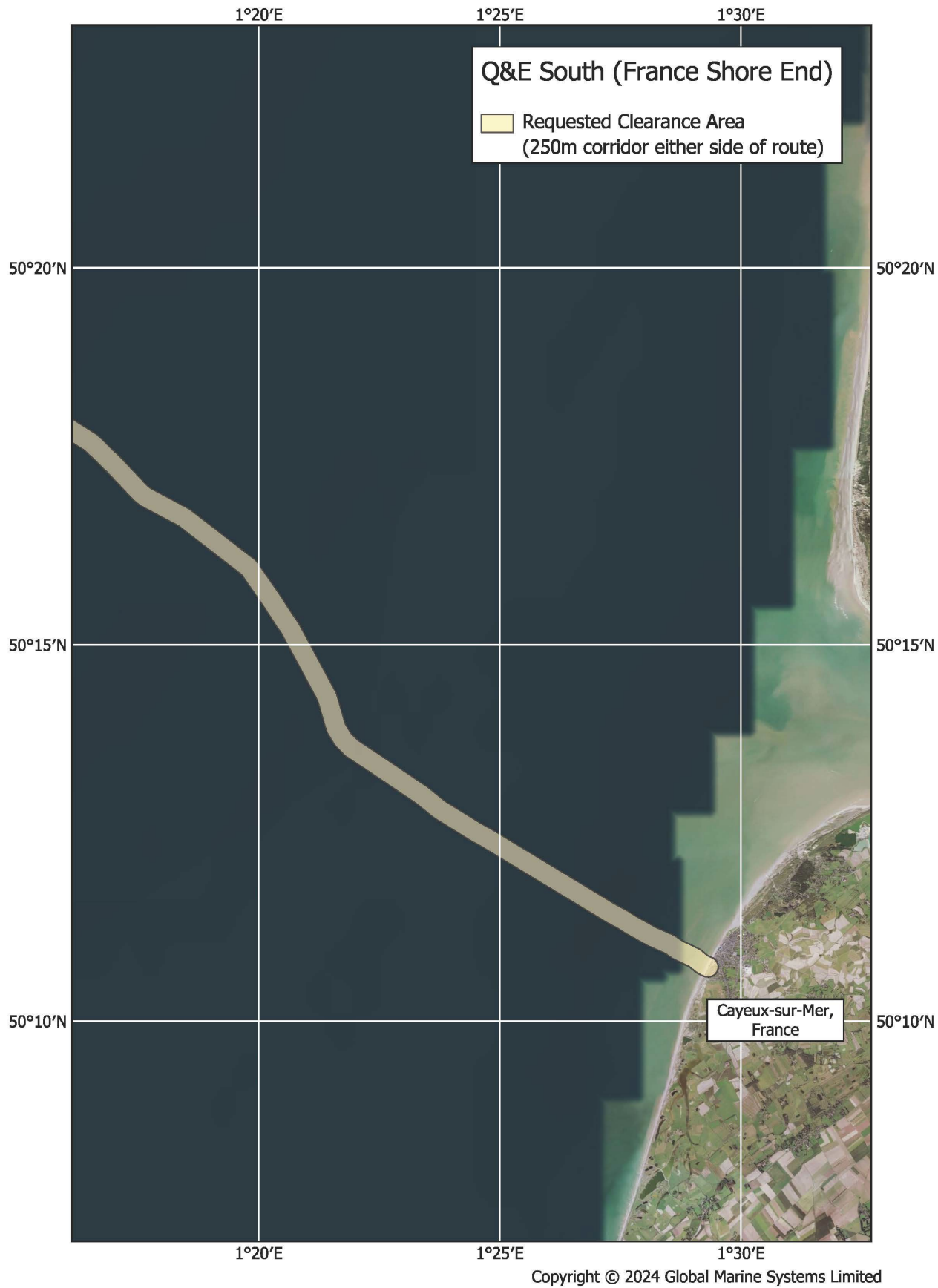
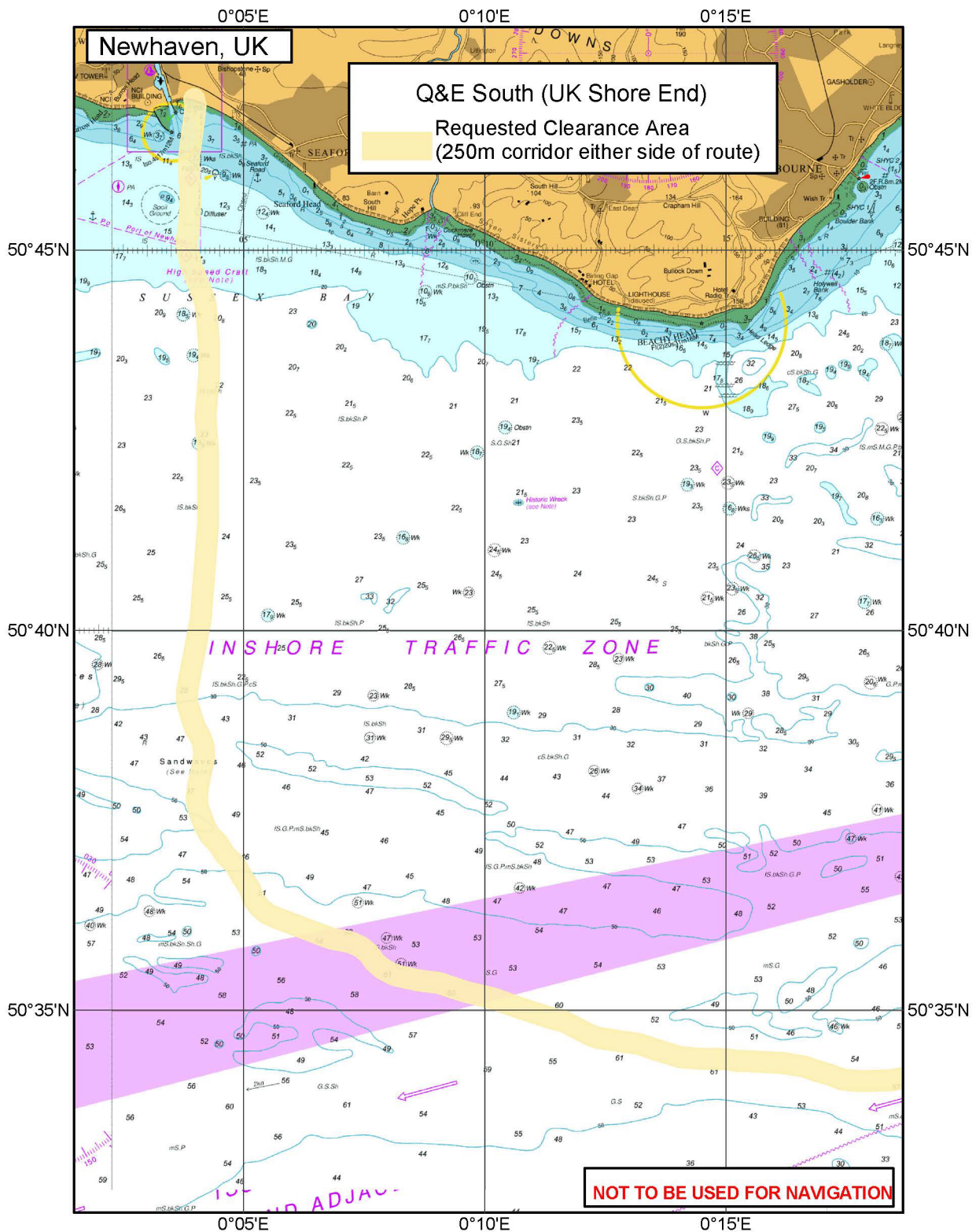


Figure 2 France Shore End

Operations Overview

There will be various operational campaigns and vessels associated with the project, these are outlined below:

Operation	Brief Description	Associated Vessels
Direct Shore End (DSE)	Smaller vessels will support cable pull-in at the UK cable landing.	RIBs/ small vessels
Pre-Lay Shore End (PLSE)	A vessel will install the France shore end after the main lay installation.	TBD
Pre-Lay Grapnel Run & Route Clearance (PLGR & RC)	Clearing of debris/ obstacles and out of service cables along the route.	OSV Nautilus
Installation	Installing of the marine cable from the Main Lay Vessel (MLV), supported by tugs.	CS Sovereign, Wulf 7 and Grossnordsee
Guard vessels	Guard vessels may be on site during and/or following installation and prior to PLIB operations.	
Post Lay Inspection and Burial (PLIB)	Identifying and burying required areas along the cable route.	Grand Canyon III

The operational VHF channel for project vessels is Channel 8 and all vessels will monitor Channel 16. Vessels are encouraged to seek further information from local port authorities in areas of operations.

Clearance Required

The vessels will be limited in manoeuvrability therefore, vessels working in the area should proceed with caution and alert the vessel within 1NM from the cable ship during operations and all activity should remain clear 250m either side of the vessel, 500m corridor in total.
