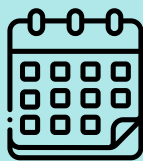


# Shrimp Permit Byelaw 2018

The shrimp permit year runs from August 1<sup>st</sup> until July 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year. To fish for shrimp within the EIFCA district you must hold a valid permit.



A 'Category 1' Permit will be required to fish for shrimp within the Wash and North Norfolk Coast SAC

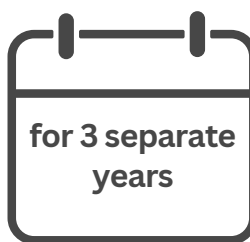

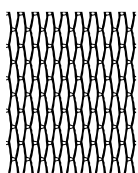

## 2 Gear Restrictions



Nets must have a veil net or sorting grid fitted

Shoes must be flat along their entire length



No tickler chains, or any item that penetrates the seabed

**Gear must be certified by an IFCA Officer prior to fishing - please apply early**

## 3 Catch Returns

- Category 1 permit holders must provide weekly catch returns
- Your permit may be suspended if you do not
- Returns must include location fished using EIFCA Charts
