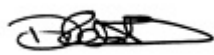

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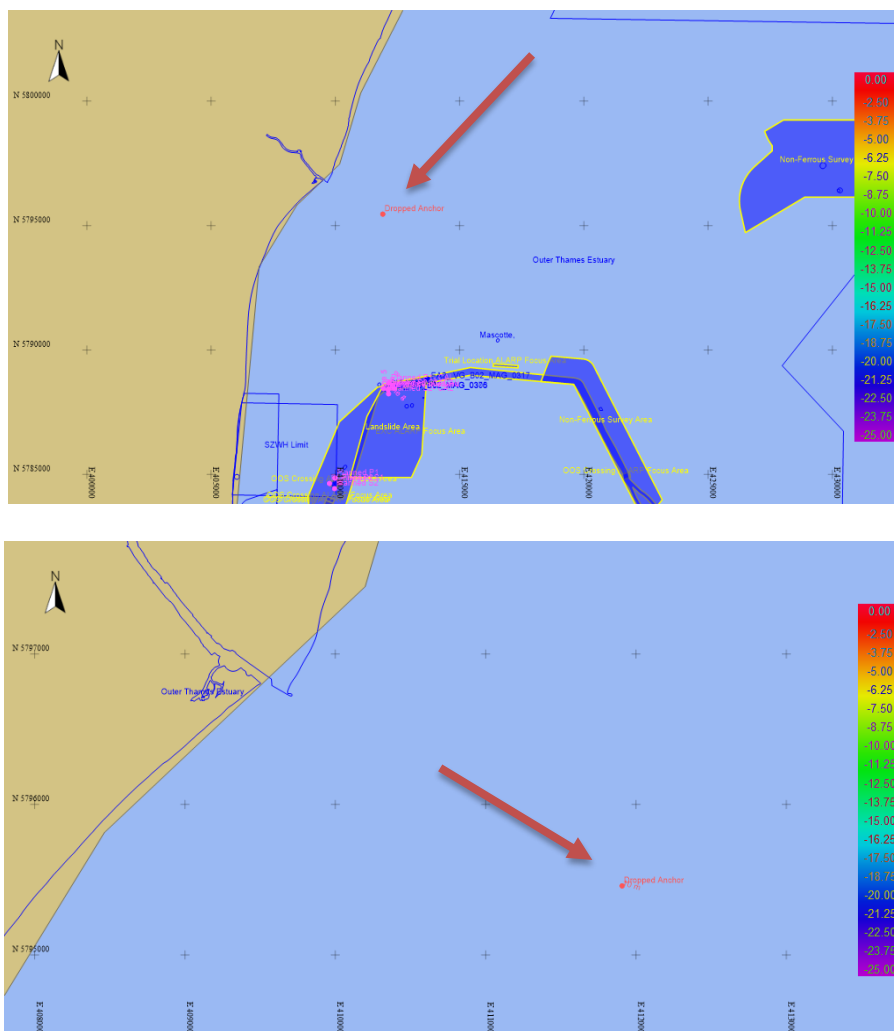
1 Notice summary

During difficult weather conditions, the Tor Boreas lost a delta flipper anchor. The vessel was on location mooring on a single anchor weather veining. It was reported that the anchor wire was 'snatching' and the decision was made to return to port.

Before the vessel recovered the anchor the anchor wire parted from the vessel thus leaving x1 anchor (approx. 850kg) and approx. 110m of wire on the seabed.

The anchor is approx. 1.7m x 1.5m with 20mm diameter steel wire rope. Rope is negatively buoyant and will be on the seabed.

A lift plan is being generated to recover the anchor back to deck at the earliest opportunity.
